A group of EHF handball experts will be also present in Gothenburg in order to cover the field of teaching and observing the EHF Young Referees.

When making travel arrangements for your referee couple, take the following into consideration:

Arrival (hotel): Sunday, 3 July 2011 (until 17:00 hrs. at the latest)
Departure: Saturday, 9 July 2011 (from morning onwards)

Please provide the local organiser (✉ malin@partillecup.com) as well as the EHF (✉ kovacic@eurohandball.com) with a copy of the final travel schedule as soon as possible and **by Friday, 10 June at the latest.**

We would like to point out to you that the detailed travel schedule is of high importance because the local organiser needs to arrange airport terminal pick-up / drop-off.

The travel expenses as well as eventual visa costs must be paid by the national federation or the referees themselves. However, it is the idea of the EHF that the referees are able to travel together with the national delegation of their respective country participating in the 2011 M19 EO Championship.

The EHF will bear the cost of accommodation for the nominated referee couples (in double room) including full board and the cost of the course.
